Note: Many repairs may not be made unless the bicycle and/or parts have been thoroughly cleaned. A cleaning fee may be assessed by the mechanic. Any cleaning fee will first be discussed with the customer.

Repair Policies

1. Only University of New Mexico student, faculty or staff may have their bicycle serviced at the Bicycle Shop. Valid UNM identification required.
2. All prices do not include parts. If new parts are needed to complete the repair, you will be contacted prior to the installation to obtain your approval.
3. All prices are based on average repair time. If an excessive amount of time over the average is needed, additional charges may be assessed.
4. All work is guaranteed for 30 days.
5. All bicycles are repaired on a first-come, first-served basis. Appointments may be made with the mechanic on duty.
6. All prices, policies and hours of operation are subject to change without notice.
7. For installation of bike parts, all clients must fill out (complete) manufacturer's warranty or registration forms and sign waiver allowing UNM bicycle mechanics to install (new) bike parts.
8. Authorized staff only allowed within bicycle shop

Wheelchair Services (limited)

Limited wheelchair service options are available at the Bicycle Shop. Please call in advance for more information! **Be sure to register your bicycle with the UNM Police Department!**

Rental Policies

1. Only University of New Mexico students, faculty and staff may rent equipment or purchase merchandise from the Outdoor Shop. Valid UNM I.D. required. New Mexico state tax law prohibits us from accepting UNM alumni ID cards.
2. Payment of any additional rental, cleaning, damage, repair or replacement fees will be conducted internally or via the UNM Bursars office, dependent on the extent of the equipment status..

3. It is the renter's responsibility to ensure that all of the equipment is complete and in the condition as indicated on the rental contract before the equipment leaves the Outdoor Shop.

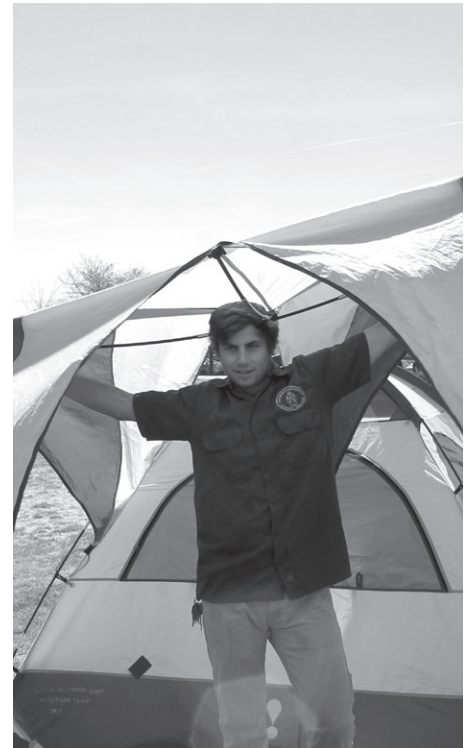
4. The length of rental is determined by counting the number of days following the date of rental to the date of return. For example: Monday to Tuesday is one day. Monday to Wednesday is two days. Minimum rental is one day. Special rates may apply during University holidays and Outdoor Shop closures.

5. All returned equipment will be inspected immediately upon its return. If the equipment is found to be damaged or incomplete, you will be charged an additional fee. Renters will also be assessed cleaning fees for equipment returned wet or dirty.

6. The renter will be assessed a \$1.00 per day late fee in addition to the daily rental fee for all equipment returned past the indicated date of return on the rental contract.

7. Reservations are accepted Tuesday through Friday of the week you need the equipment. Reservations may be made in person or by phone. The full rental fee will be forfeited if the reserved equipment is not picked up by the day of the rental or without 24-hour prior notification of cancellation. Refunds will be made by University check or credit voucher. Rental fees must be paid in person.

8. No business will be conducted outside normal operating hours. It is the sole responsibility of the renter to be aware of the Outdoor Shop's hours of operation. **Equipment will not be accepted at the Recreational Services Office.**
